## Call to Worship: Psalm 78:23-29 (ESV)

<sup>78:23</sup> Yet he commanded the skies above  
and opened the doors of heaven,  
<sup>24</sup> and he rained down on them manna to eat  
and gave them the grain of heaven.  
<sup>25</sup> Man ate of the bread of the angels;  
he sent them food in abundance.  
<sup>26</sup> He caused the east wind to blow in the heavens,  
and by his power he led out the south wind;  
<sup>27</sup> he rained meat on them like dust,  
winged birds like the sand of the seas;  
<sup>28</sup> he let them fall in the midst of their camp,  
all around their dwellings.  
<sup>29</sup> And they ate and were well filled,  
for he gave them what they craved.
