What should I expect during the
Time of Healing Prayer?

Those desiring healing for any type of issue (physical, emotional, spiritual, generational, etc.) or a blessing may come to the front to receive prayer.

Anyone who desires prayer but has difficulty coming forward may raise their hand or send someone else with the request for prayer, and a prayer minister or ministers can go to the individual to pray with them at their seat.

During this time some gentle worship music (often referred to as “soaking prayer music”) will be played in the background, to help us all focus on God and experience His presence. Whether or not you come forward for specific prayer, God may minister to you directly during this time, granting peace, healing, refreshing, or revelation. Be open to receiving from God during this time!
