transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory,
which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.”**

For the gospel to be preached in word & deed, let us pray:

Thank You Lord that it shall come to pass

that You will pour out Your Spirit on all flesh;

our sons and our daughters shall prophesy,

our old men shall dream dreams,

and our young men shall see visions.

For obedience and provision, let us pray:
