Thanksgiving, Praise & Adoration

Let's thank God for His goodness, His Word, and His ways:

**Sing praises to the Lord, O you his saints,
and give thanks to his holy name.
For his anger is but for a moment,
and his favor is for a lifetime.
Weeping may tarry for the night,
but joy comes with the morning.**

For the Church

For unity and revival, let us pray:

May the Father, out of His glorious riches, strengthen us with power through His Spirit in our inner being, so that Christ may dwell in our hearts through faith. And may we, being rooted and established in love, have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that we may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

For obedience and provision, let us pray:

**Thank You Lord that Your Word says:

**No good thing does he withhold
